## KLRS Winter Operations 2023-2024

The Kluane Lake Research Station will be open by request for winter operations from October 2023 through April 2024. Full-service research support resumes mid-April 2024.

### Facilities available for winter use

**Accommodation:** The Walter Wood building is available for winter use and will accommodate about 6 users. The Wood building has a propane heater and a wood stove. Additional users can be accommodated in cabins, heated by wood stoves. Station users need to provide their own sleeping bag and other personal gear. Pillows, pillowcases, and sheets for the beds will be provided. Two outhouses are available for users – the summer washroom and laundry facilities are not available.

**Kitchen:** Kitchen facilities in the Wood building include a propane stove/oven, toaster, and fridge. Kitchen supplies (bowls, plates, pots, pans, utensils, etc.) are available. Users must bring their own food to cook – there will be no kitchen staff on site. There is no running water in the winter. Water for drinking and cooking will be provided in blue jugs.

**Power:** Electricity is available for all bookings and can be kept on while users are temporarily away from the station to ensure continued power for instruments.

**Communications:** Internet and phone are available. A satellite phone will be provided in case of power outage.

**Workspace:** The Wood building can be used as an office space. Other lab space can be opened on request, depending on requirements – please contact us to discuss.

**Staff:** The Station Manager will visit the station regularly to support users as needed. The Station Manager will always be on call while users are at the station in case of emergency.

### Winter rates
